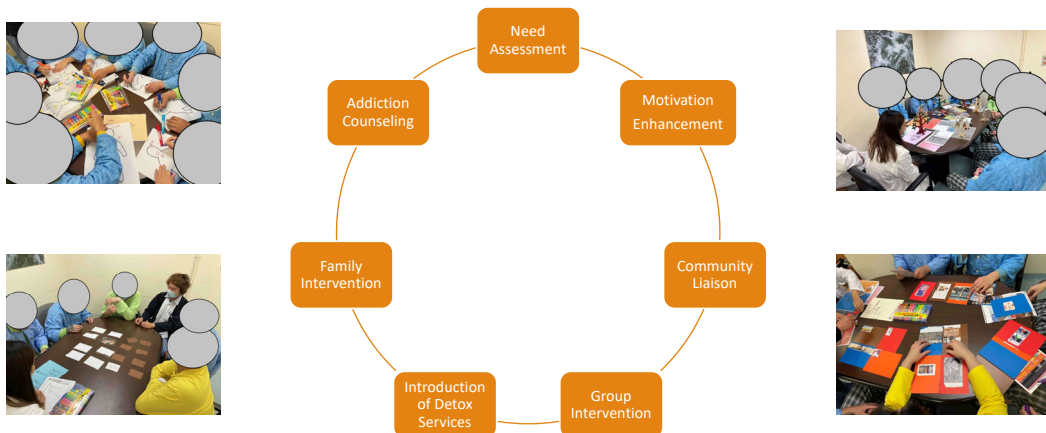

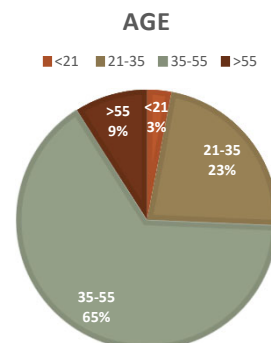
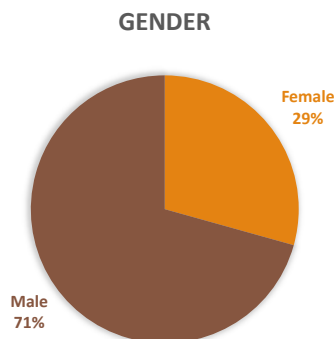


Evaluation on Output Indicators

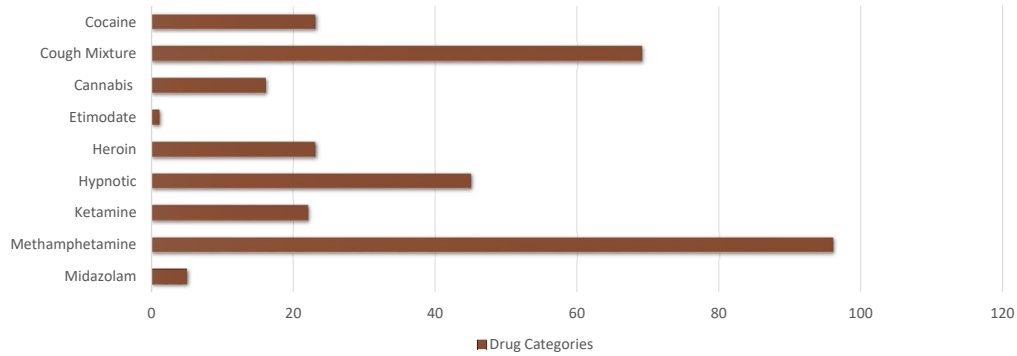
Output Indicator	Description of Indicator	Output Achieved
1	Provide assessment to 300 substance abusers	Provided assessments for 300 (100%) substance abusers
2	Provide 1,200 outreach interventions to 120 substance abusers	Provided 1434 (119.5%) outreach interventions for 120 (100%) substance abusers
3	Provide 320 outreach interventions to 80 carers of substance abusers	Provided 422 (131.9%) outreach interventions for 105 (131.3%) carers of substance abusers
4	Provide 24 group sessions to substance abusers with a total of 120 attendants	Provided 30 (125%) group sessions for 148 (123.3%) substance abusers

Evaluation on Outcome Indicators

Outcome Indicator	Target	Outcome Achieved
1	70% of drug abusers reduce or stop the substance use after completion of the program	Beat Drugs Fund Question Set No. 6 86.5% showed reduction in frequency of substance abuse
2	70% of participants show improvement in psychiatric co-morbidity / statistical significant improvement in psychiatric co-morbidity	Brief Psychiatric Rating Scale (BPRS) 77.5% showed improvement in psychiatric co-morbidity The Depression, Anxiety and Stress Scale - 21 Items (DASS-21) 91.8% showed improvement in psychiatric co-morbidity
3	70% of participants show improvement in functional status / statistical significant improvement in functional status	Christo Inventory for Substance-misuse Services (CISS) 93.7% showed improvement in functional status
4	70% of participants show improvement in readiness to quit drugs / statistical significant improvement in readiness to quit drugs	Beat Drugs Fund Question Set No. 13 91.9% showed improvement in readiness to quit drugs
5	70% of participants show improvement in capacity to support drug abusing family members / statistical significant improvement in capacity to support drug abusing family members	Beat Drugs Fund Question Set No. 20 96.9% showed improvement in capacity to support drug abusing family members
