

Examples of Objectives for Beat Drugs Fund Projects (Application Form Part D(II))

The following objectives are for illustrative purpose only. Applicants should propose objectives that are relevant to their projects.

Preventive Education and Publicity Projects

1. To cultivate an anti-drug attitude among high-risk youths.
 - Tool for evaluation: BDF Question Set No. 16 or 18
2. To strengthen young people's awareness of Cannabis related harm.
 - Tool for evaluation: BDF Question Set No. 24 or 25
3. To improve the awareness of parents on early identification of hidden drug abusers.
 - Tool for evaluation: BDF Question Set No. 19
4. To promote ethnic minority (EM) new immigrants' understanding of the legal consequence of drug abuse.
 - Tool for evaluation: 10-20 items of tailor-made quiz question (pre-test and post-test)

Treatment and Rehabilitation Projects

5. To sustain abstinence in drug use among ex-residents of Drug Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre (DTRC).
 - Tool for evaluation: BDF Question Set No. 5, 6 or 7
6. To reduce the relapse rate among clients of Counselling Centres for Psychotropic Substance Abusers (CCPSA).
 - Tool for evaluation: BDF Question Set No. 6 or 7
7. To improve the cognitive function and social function of patients who attend Substance Abuse Clinic (SAC).
 - Tool for measuring improvement in cognitive function: Rivermead Behavioural Memory Test (RBMT)
 - Tool for measuring improvement in social function: Social Adjustment Scale Self-report, Social Adaptation Self-Evaluation Scale or SF-36
8. To improve the employment rate of rehabilitated drug abusers.
 - Outcome indicator: Employment rate at 3 months after training (using telephone survey)
9. To incorporate 6 hours of training on identification, counselling and treatment of drug abusers into the existing post-graduate training programs for social work professionals.

- Outcome indicator: BDF Question Set No. 21(a)
10. To organise a Continued Nursing Education (CNE) or Continued Medical Education (CME) accreditation course on drug abuse management and relapse prevention counselling skills.
- Outcome indicator: BDF Question Set No. 21(b)
11. To improve drug abusers' motivation to quit drugs.
- Tool for evaluation: BDF Question Set No. 13
12. To enable family members of drug abusers to support drug abusers under different stages of quitting readiness.
- Tool for evaluation: BDF Question Set No. 20

預防教育和宣傳項目

1. 培養青少年抗拒吸毒的態度。
 - 評估成效的工具：禁毒基金第 16 或 18 號問卷
2. 強化青年對吸食大麻相關禍害的意識。
 - 評估成效的工具：禁毒基金第 24 或 25 號問卷
3. 提昇家長對及早識別隱蔽吸毒者的意識。
 - 評估成效的工具：禁毒基金第 19 號問卷
4. 讓少數族裔新移民更了解吸毒的刑事責任。
 - 評估成效的工具：自訂一份有 10-20 項的問卷，進行前測及後測

戒毒治療和康復項目

5. 令曾入住戒毒治療及康復中心 (DTRC) 的更新人士持續地停止吸毒。
 - 評估成效的工具：禁毒基金第 5、6 或 7 號問卷
6. 降低濫用精神藥物者輔導中心 (CCPSA) 的服務使用者的重吸率。
 - 評估成效的工具：禁毒基金第 6 或 7 號問卷
7. 提昇物質濫用診所 (SAC) 病人的認知及社交能力。
 - 評估有關提昇認知能力的工具：Rivermead 行為記憶測驗 (Rivermead Behavioural Memory Test, RBMT)
 - 評估有關提昇社交能力的工具：社會適應量表自我評量版 (Social Adjustment Scale – Self-Report, SAS-SR 或 Social Adaptation Self-Evaluation Scale, SASS) 或 SF-36 生活品質量表
8. 提高戒毒康復者的就業率。
 - 評估成效的指標：培訓後 3 個月的就業率(以電話訪問)
9. 在社福界進修培訓課程中加入六小時有關識別吸毒者、輔導及戒毒治療和的培訓。
 - 評估成效的指標：禁毒基金第 21(a)號問卷
10. 舉辦有關戒毒治療和預防重吸輔導技巧的護理學持續教育課程 (CNE) 或醫學持續教育 (CME) 進修課程。
 - 評估成效的指標：禁毒基金第 21(b)號問卷
11. 提升吸毒者的戒毒動機。
 - 評估成效的工具：禁毒基金第 13 號問卷
12. 使吸毒者的家人能按吸毒者身處的不同改變階段之需要向其提供協助。
 - 評估成效的工具：禁毒基金第 20 號問卷
